# **After School Activities Policies & Information**

## **ENROLLMENT**

- Applications for After School Activities are accepted on a first come first serve basis.
- If we are unable to accommodate your registration or there is any problem with your registration you will be notified.
- Any child wishing to join a program after the start-date may do so at the discretion of the Instructor and Activities Director, but not after the 3rd week of programming. No child will be permitted to join a program after week 3.
- If a club does not meet the minimum required enrollment, it may be cancelled. These decisions will be made based on enrollment up to one week prior to the start of the club.
- All after school activities will be held at Jackson School, Walnut Park, or Student Center unless noted otherwise.

## **PAYMENT AND PICK UP**

- All fees for Activities will be billed through FACTS.
- Please be sure to update your FACTS account with your authorized pick up and emergency contact information.
- Dismissal will be from the location listed in the activity description. Parents or authorized adults must sign the child out of activity upon pickup. \*\*Due to COVID the instructors are checking the students out.
- Parents are responsible to inform their child who will be picking him/her up after the activity.
- Please bring and be ready to present a photo ID when picking up your child. Safety and security are a priority for all.
- After School programs have different end times. Please be prompt.

## LATE PICK UP POLICY

- Promptness at pickup is essential for children and staff alike. A late fee of \$15.00 will be charged each time a child is picked up late, up to 10 minutes after the designated end time. An additional \$2.00 per minute will be charged for every minute after the first 10 minutes. If your child is picked up late more than three times, the school reserves the right to terminate your child's enrollment in the After-School program.

## COMMUNICATION

- Parents are responsible to inform classroom teachers of any changes in their child's activity schedule. Please CC [activities@jwpschools.org](mailto:activities@jwpschools.org) in the email.
- Information regarding a final class presentation will be provided by the instructor if such presentations are offered.
- Please ensure that you provide a valid email address and phone number at the time of registration - communication regarding clubs is done through email or phone.

## CANCELLATION

- Parents will be notified through email and phone when an activity has been cancelled or postponed due to any circumstance that may arise, i.e. sickness or weather.
- If a club is cancelled due to inclement weather or other unforeseen circumstances, the instructor will make every effort to plan a makeup class for the children. Make-up classes are not guaranteed.

### PLEASE NOTE:

- **If club is cancelled BEFORE 6pm the day before** and you are not able to pick up your child at the end of the school day, there will be a \$15 fee for the student to participate in Kids Corner or Homework & More until club dismissal time.
- **If the club is cancelled AFTER 6pm the day before** and you are not able to pick up your child at the end of the school day, there will be no fee for the student to participate in Kids Corner or Homework Club until club dismissal time.

## HEALTH AND SAFETY

- The emergency information on FACTS will be used for the activity instructors.
- Parents are responsible to keep emergency information on FACTS updated and accurate, including medical information, and inform instructors of any change after the start of the school year.
- Your children will have an opportunity to eat their snack before class begins. Please make sure any snacks sent are **NUT SAFE!**
- Please be advised that the ability to listen and to follow direction is required of all children participating in After School Activities. If a child is unable to participate cooperatively or becomes disruptive to the group, parents will be asked to withdraw the child from the program.
- Following the end of the school day, a JWP staff member or Activity Instructor will walk students to their club.
- Children registered in Kids Corner following the end of an activity will be released to Kids Corner Staff.

## HOMEWORK CLUB

- Homework Club meets Monday-Thursday in the Jackson School. The program provides a supervised, supportive atmosphere for study. Students should come prepared with a book to read for pleasure.
- Homework Club is open in hour increments from 2:50-4:50 pm at the rate of \$15.00 per hour. Students are able to register by the hour, or for two hours.
  - Hour 1: 2:50-3:50 .....\$15.00
  - Hour 2: 3:50-4:50 .....\$15.00
  - 2 Hours: 2:50-4:50 .....\$30.00
- To register: Email the students' teacher and [activities@jwpschools.org](mailto:activities@jwpschools.org) indicating the day and time. You will receive a confirmation email indicating that the registration was successful.
- Pick up is from the front of the Jackson School.

## **KIDS' CORNER**

- Kids' Corner is available each afternoon until 6:00. Students who attend Kids' Corner will spend their afternoon either at Walnut Park or in the Student Center.
- If your child participates in both After School Activities and Kids' Corner (on the same day) you will be charged \$30 for the session as opposed to \$40.
