#### FINANCIAL AID FOR APPLICANT FAMILIES

Financial aid is need-based and open to all students who apply to our school. Please notify the Admissions Office of your intent to apply for financial aid and we can provide you with additional information to help guide you through the process.

In order to be considered for a financial aid award, you must (1) complete your online application at FACTS Tuition Management ([online.factsmgmt.com/aid](https://online.factsmgmt.com/aid)) and (2) if you have additional information to share, submit a Letter of Circumstance to the Office of Admissions, no later than March 15, 2020.

Financial Aid Applicants will be notified of their aid award by March 20, 2020.

The following documents are needed to complete a financial aid application online:

- 2019 Tax returns if they are done, if not 2018 Tax returns should be submitted with 2019 W-2's or income verification, until 2019 Tax returns can be submitted.
- Documentation of other income (welfare, food stamps, child support, etc.)
- Recent pay stub(s)
- Credit or debit card for Smart Tuition application fee

We offer a Tuition Insurance plan, Protect My Insurance, through The Hanover Insurance Group. The details, cost of coverage, and plan will be included here in your Enrollment packet.
